1. OVERVIEW

1.1 Perry Lakes Hawks Basketball Association is subject to the Basketball WA Tribunal By-Laws, which may be amended from time to time.

2. REPORTS

- 2.1 BWA Reports can only be lodged by a PLHBA Official, through the submission of an Official BWA Report Form.
- 2.1.1 For the avoidance of doubt, PLHBA Officials include:
 - 2.1.1.1 Rostered Games Controllers
 - 2.1.1.2 Rostered Referee Supervisors
 - 2.1.1.3 Rostered Referee Coaches
 - 2.1.1.4 Rostered Competition Staff
 - 2.1.1.5 Rostered Referees
 - 2.1.1.6 PLHBA Management
- 2.2 A BWA Report can be lodged in relation to any person, team or club, as required.

3. TRIBUNALS

- 3.1 Following receipt of a BWA Report, a tribunal may be scheduled to hear the matter.
- 3.1.1 In some instances, an Administrative Tribunal may be appropriate to address the matter.
- 3.1.1.1 This is at the discretion of PLHBA Management.
- 3.2 The PLHBA will appoint the CPM as the Tribunal Officer were possible.
- 3.2.1 Any person reported may be required to answer the alleged charge made by appearing in person before a tribunal hearing.
- 3.2.2 The reported person will be advised the following facts by the Tribunal Officer within seventy-two (72) hours of the report being filled, not submitted:
- 3.2.2.1 Date that the report was submitted.
- 3.2.2.2 Details of the alleged charges on the report.
- 3.2.2.3 Date, time and venue of the tribunal hearing.
 - 3.2.2.3.1 For all Junior Domestic Competition related BWA Reports, the Domestic Club the reported person is associated with will be advised on the above facts by the Tribunal Officer.
- 3.2.3 The tribunal may still proceed in the vent that the charged person, having been duly notified, fails to attend.
- 3.2.4 The tribunal may suspend the charge person until such time as they make themselves available for a tribunal hearing.
