TRIAL INFORMATION

The upcoming 2025 State Championships/2026 WABL season trials, commence next week. Please review the following important details to ensure your child is fully prepared. All Information is on our website too.

New Athlete Sign-In Procedure

All athletes must sign in at the BBC foyer using tablet stations. The process is simple:

- 1. Select Male or Female
- 2. Choose the appropriate age group
- 3. Locate your child's name (scroll or type surname)
- 4. A photo will be taken and a trial number assigned
- 5. Helpers will mark the athlete's arm and leg with their number
- 6. Athletes will be directed to assemble before entering the court

Closed Trial Sessions

Please note: No parents or spectators are permitted in the court area. You may wait in the café area or return at the end of the session.

Please check the trial schedule carefully & regularly, as some times may change

Athlete Requirements

- Attire: Reversible singlet or T-shirt, shorts without pockets
- Equipment: Clearly labelled water bottle, basketball, and optional mouthguard


